



COUNCIL OF SCHOOL OFFICERS' PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT POLICY

PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION MEMBERSHIP FEES

Each full dues paying member can receive payment for membership fees for a professional organization directly aligned to the specific job for which they are hired in DC Public Schools.

- a. Membership fees will be paid or reimbursed up to \$350 per academic school year.
- b. Each member will be afforded one (1) membership per academic school year.
- c. In order to be eligible for reimbursement, all documents must be submitted within 45 business days after payment of membership dues.

PROFESSIONAL CONFERENCE REGISTRATION REIMBURSEMENT

Each full dues paying member can receive reimbursement for registration to a professional conference directly aligned to the specific job for which they are hired in DC Public Schools.

- a. Registration fee reimbursement will be up to \$300 per academic year.
- b. In order to request reimbursement, the member must provide proof of registration for the specific conference. A member will be afforded one (1) conference registration reimbursement each academic school year.
- c. In order to be eligible for reimbursement, all documents must be submitted within 45 business days after conclusion of the conference.

TUITION REIMBURSEMENT

Each full dues paying member can receive tuition reimbursement directly aligned to the specific job function for which they are hired in DC Public Schools.

- a. Tuition reimbursement will be up to \$500 per semester or \$1000 per academic school year.
- b. In order to request reimbursement, the member must provide proof of paid registration for the specific class. A member can be afforded one (1) tuition reimbursement each semester (2 each academic school year).
- c. In order to be eligible for reimbursement, all documents must be submitted within 45 business days after the conclusion of the specific course.

In order to receive reimbursement, the member must submit proof of payment for the specific request for reimbursement, electronically, to the CSO Office to the attention of zchilds@csolocal4.org.

The Council of School Officers will provide, when appropriate, professional development opportunities for any full dues paying member.
